Hildy Teegen is Dean of the Moore School of Business. Prior to coming to the University of South Carolina in September, 2007, she was director of The George Washington University's Center for International Business Education and Research (CIBER) in Washington, DC. Dr. Teegen also held a joint appointment at GW as Professor of International Business at the School of Business and Professor of International Affairs at the Elliott School.

As director of CIBER at The George Washington University, Dr. Teegen focused on brokering relationships and forging links – with the greater university, with students, with alumni, and with other “outside constituents” such as the government and the private sector.

Dr. Teegen has written extensively about global business, most recently about interactions between firms, governments and nongovernmental organizations. She has edited two books, and co-authored two more: *Case Studies of Economic Sanctions: The Chinese, Cuban and Iranian Experiences* and *U.S. Economic Sanctions: Philosophy and Efficacy*.

Dr. Teegen earned her bachelor's degrees in Latin American Studies and International Business and Finance from the University of Texas at Austin in 1987. In 1993 she received her PH.D. in International Business (with a subspecialty in Marketing Strategy and economic Development) also from the University of Texas at Austin.

Fluent in Spanish, Dr. Teegen has lived in Mexico, Portugal, the Dominican Republic and Grand Cayman Island. She has taught international business at the George Washington University, The College of William and Mary, Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México in Mexico City, The University of Texas at Austin, Instituto Tecnológico y de Estudios Superiores de Monterrey (ITESM) in Monterrey, Mexico, and Universidade do Porto in Oporto, Portugal.
